55% Merlot
20% Cabernet Sauvignon
25% Cabernet Franc

- Wine Making:

Traditional wine making
with maceration during 10 to 15 days.
Pumping and frequent power cuts
during the fermentation phase.

- Tasting Notes:

Black cherry, currant and spicy flavors
are frank and balanced in this fresh
medium-bodied red, with ripe tannins
to support the juicy texture.
Shows good focus and a clean ripe finish.

- Food Pairing:

This wine will be perfect
with white meat and cheeses.

- Service:

To be served at 17°C.
