- Grapes:

45 % Braucol
20 % Cabernet Sauvignon
20 % Cabernet Franc
15 % Syrah

- Selection of the best parcels:

For this exceptional cuvee, rigorous selection of the oldest and most beautiful vineyards plots was performed.

- Wine Making:

Separate fermentation of each varietal.
Temperature control.
Each third of the harvest has been ageing in French oak barrels for 6 months in the quiet darkness of a cool cellar (18 months).

- Tasting notes:

Strong color of deep and brilliant red.
The nose combines powerful ripe fruit with voluptuous woody notes.
The attack is smooth.
Mouth, while round, displays a rich and concentrated structure;
tannins are intense but polished.

- Food Pairing:

Red meat, game and cheeses will find here a company of character.

- Service:

Decanting an hour will express his great personality.
Serve at 17 to 18 degrees.

- Ageing Potential:

The prestige cuvee of Chateau Labastidié can easily maintain 10 years.
